



Canvas (“LMS”) Data in Navigate

Canvas activity and assignment information is now available in Navigate. Use it to spot patterns, prepare for conversations, and ask better questions, but not as a stand-alone basis for decisions.

You can now see:

- Last Canvas login for a student
- Assignments by course, including grades and past-due items
- Current LMS score
- Assignment metadata you can search or filter by course and assignment
- Lists of students based on LMS activity or assignment results

You can see Canvas items:

- On a student’s profile: Overview (last login to Canvas date) & Courses (course-level assignment details and current LMS score)
- Within Advanced Search: Course Data (search by the number of days since last Canvas activity, by course)
- Within Advanced Search: LMS Assignments (search by course, assignment type, assignment status, point range, and number of assignments)

Good advising uses:

- Academic standards appointment prep and conversations
- Drop/withdrawal appointment prep and conversations
- Broadly see how a student's classes/assignments are going
- Proactive advising
 - Example: Pull a list of CHEM 1210 students and see those below a C- grade - --> Reach out to discuss withdrawal

Read before using:

- The information is FERPA-protected.
- The information is not real-time: Expect a one-day delay from Canvas.
- Instructor usage of Canvas varies: Completeness depends on how instructors use Canvas.
- Items labelled as “Assignments” in Navigate refer to every *graded item*, including quizzes and midterms.
- Context is limited: Navigate does not show assignment weight, late work policies, assignment replacement policies, or how classmates are performing.
- Do not make decisions from this data alone: Treat it as one data point and confirm details with the student or instructor.
- Anyone with advisor-level access is be able to view Canvas items, including career coaches.
